Appling County will achieve these District Goals set for our students, staff, and community:

Goal 1: By June 2022, students will show measurable progress in ELA as evidenced by a 3% growth in all learner categories (beginning, developing, proficient, distinguished) as measured by the Georgia Milestone Assessment.

Goal 2: By June 2022, students will show measurable progress in Mathematics as evidenced by a 3% growth in all learner categories (beginning, developing, proficient, distinguished) as measured by the Georgia Milestone Assessment.
