How can I schedule a COVID-19 vaccination appointment?

If you are a part of one of the categories listed above, you are eligible to receive your COVID-19 vaccine. Please call **1-855-473-4374** to schedule an appointment.

To self-register, please visit <https://dph.georgia.gov/covid-vaccine>, and select the blue box that states "Health Dept. Scheduling". You will then be directed to the VRAS registration system. For more information regarding eligibility, please visit dph.georgia.gov.

*When vaccine supply becomes limited or unavailable, we will pause scheduling additional COVID-19 vaccination appointments in an effort to ensure vaccine supply for those with standing appointments or those in need of their second dose of the vaccine.

Is there any other information I should know before scheduling my vaccination appointment?

An appointment is **necessary** to receive a COVID-19 vaccine at any of our sites as this allows us to ensure adequate vaccine supply.
